TSUNAMI® 100 PROGRAM REDUCES TOTAL PLATE COUNTS AT A WESTERN MIXED VEGETABLE PROCESSOR.

Problem:

Plant management needed to eliminate erratic total plate counts in flume water and the practice of mixing three chemicals on site to produce chlorine dioxide. Facility had difficulty maintaining control of chemical usage on chlorine dioxide program.

Solution:

Replace chlorine dioxide with Tsunami 100 product fed directly to the vegetable chiller water.

Results:

Tsunami 100 had an immediate impact in reducing total plate counts in the chill water. During the treatment period, there was much less fluctuation in counts on a daily basis. Chemical usage was tightly controlled in the chill water due to Tsunami's low reactivity with soils and organics.
